BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA)/BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (BS)

ASSOCIATE OF ARTS (AA) AND ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE (AS) DEGREES

Associate of Arts (AA) and Associate of Science (AS) degrees are programs of study recognized by the Utah Board of Regents intended to encourage exploration of academic options and prepare students for upper-division work in baccalaureate programs and/or for employment. A minimum of 61 total credits.

Associate of Applied Science Degrees (AAS)

The Associate of Applied Science degree is offered for students who plan to seek employment immediately after completing their program of study. It requires a majority of the training to be in specific career and technical education theory and skill courses.

College work for the Associate of Applied Science degree includes 63 to 69 credit hours.

Certificates and Awards

Certificates of Completion

Certificates of Completion (CC) are recognized by the Utah Board of Regents that consist of a coherent sequence of courses typically one year in length (30-33 semester credit hours or 900-990 clock hours). Certificates of completion indicate a student's readiness for entry-level employment.

Certificates of Proficiency

Certificates of Proficiency (CP) are programs of study approved by the SLCC Board of Trustees and recognized by the Utah Board of Regents that consist of a coherent sequence of courses typically less than one year in length (16-29 semester credit hours or 600-899 clock hours). Certificates of Proficiency may be entry-level or may require prerequisites of related industry experience and/or previous course work or degree attainment.

Awards

Awards (CA) are granted in programs that require less than 16 credit hours to complete.
